

Specifications of grounding wire for fiber distribution box



Summary of Content

Fiber distribution boxes should be grounded using copper conductors sized according to regional standards, with resistance kept below 0.1 ohm for system safety.

Wire Size and Material

- US Market: Use a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) copper wire for grounding the distribution box .
- Other Markets: A 6 mm² copper wire is recommended .
- For connections between mounting plates and equipment, larger wires may be required depending on cable length and number of spindles. For example, a 6 AWG (13.29 mm²) copper wire may be used in the US for longer tool cables to maintain low resistance .
- Material: Copper is preferred for all grounding conductors, especially for buried or exposed runs, as aluminum can corrode over time .

Connection Points

- Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the housing to the mounting plate.
- Connect a second grounding wire from the mounting plate to the central factory grounding point .
- Ensure all metallic parts, including splice cases and cable trays, are bonded to maintain continuity .
