Material and Construction

Junction boxes are typically made from stainless steel (SS316L), hot-dip galvanized steel (SS400), or other corrosion-resistant materials suitable for the environment, including offshore or industrial settings. Non-metallic options may also be used for specific applications requiring chemical resistance or lightweight construction. The material selection depends on corrosion resistance, mechanical strength, and environmental exposure.

Degree of Protection

The Ingress Protection (IP) rating is critical to ensure the box is dust-tight and water-resistant. Common ratings for junction boxes on cable trays include IP65 or higher, providing protection against dust and water jets. For hazardous zones, compliance with API 14FZ or equivalent standards is recommended.
