Overview

Key Components

- **Main Switch/Isolator:** Allows complete disconnection of the incoming supply for maintenance or emergency purposes.
- **Circuit Breakers (MCBs, MCCBs):** Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits.
- **Residual Current Devices (RCCBs/RCBOs):** Detect leakage currents to prevent electric shocks and enhance safety.
- **Busbars:** Copper or aluminum strips that distribute power to outgoing circuits; phases can be balanced freely.
- **Neutral and Earth Bars:** Provide return paths and grounding for safety.
