

Standard Layout Requirements for Construction Site Electrical Distribution Boxes



Summary of Content

Construction site electrical distribution boxes must be installed in dry, accessible, and ventilated locations, at a standard height of 1.5–1.8 meters, with proper grounding, wiring, and protective devices to ensure safety and compliance.

Site Selection

Distribution boxes should be located close to the power supply to minimize voltage drop and power loss, while avoiding humid, corrosive, or poorly ventilated areas that could cause overheating or equipment damage. Outdoor boxes must have appropriate IP or NEMA ratings to protect against water, dust, and environmental hazards, while indoor boxes can use lighter enclosures like plastic or steel depending on durability requirements .

Installation Height and Fixing

The bottom edge of the distribution box is typically installed 1.5–1.8 meters above ground, allowing convenient operation and inspection. Boxes must be firmly fixed using mounting brackets or screws to prevent movement, tilting, or vibration damage. Modular designs are recommended for easier future upgrades .

Wiring Specifications

- Power must be turned off during installation to ensure safety.
