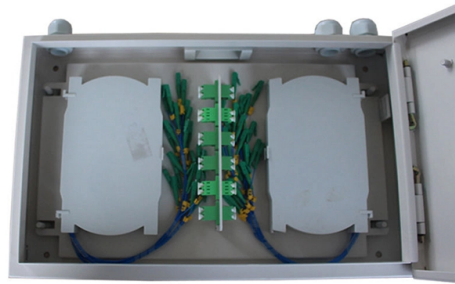


Standard Requirements for Indoor Optical Cable Laying



Summary of Content

Indoor optical cables must be installed with proper support, fire safety, bend radius adherence, tension control, and compliance with regulatory and manufacturer guidelines.

Cable Routing and Support

Indoor optical cables are typically used in horizontal subsystems (within floors) and vertical backbone subsystems (connecting equipment rooms to wiring closets). Cables must be firmly fixed along the upper, lower, and middle sections of cable channels using nylon cable ties or steel clips to prevent sagging or slipping . Vertical installations should use riser-rated cables (OFNR) and support devices to avoid crushing the cable core . Begin installation from the top of the riser to simplify pulling and reduce stress on the cable .

Bend Radius and Tension Control

Cables must not exceed the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer to prevent fiber damage . Pulling should be done using the outer jacket or strength members, never directly on the fibers. Use breakaway pulling eyes, automated pullers, or pulling tape to maintain tension control and avoid twisting or over-stressing the cable .
