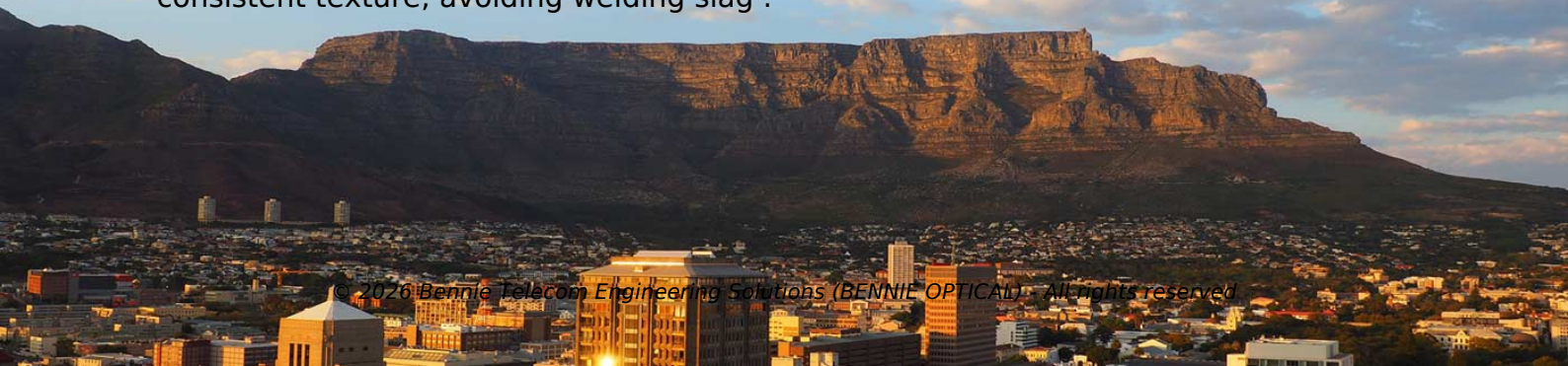
Level 3 distribution boxes require continuous, defect-free welding that meets ISO 3834 and EN ISO 5817 standards to ensure structural integrity, sealing, and corrosion resistance.

Welding Quality Standards

Level 3 distribution boxes must comply with ISO 3834, which defines quality requirements for fusion welding of metallic materials, covering personnel qualifications, welding procedures, and documentation such as Welding Procedure Specifications (WPS) and Welder Qualification Records (WPQR) to ensure consistent quality. Additionally, EN ISO 5817 specifies acceptable defect levels in welds, with Level B or C quality typically required depending on structural importance and fatigue considerations. For structural steel enclosures, EN 1090-2 links execution classes (EXC) to weld quality, ensuring that critical parts meet higher standards.

Welding Process Requirements

- **Continuous Welding:** All seams should be continuously welded rather than spot-welded to maintain sealing performance and prevent moisture ingress, which is critical for achieving IP54, IP65, or higher protection ratings.
- **Seam Finish:** Welds must be uniform, bright, and clean, free from defects such as porosity, cracks, or undercuts. Grinding should produce a flush surface with consistent texture, avoiding welding slag.
