

Standard Requirements for Wiring Installation in Distribution Boxes

Site Selection and Installation

Distribution boxes should be installed in dry, well-ventilated, and accessible areas to prevent overheating and ensure safe operation. Avoid humid, corrosive, or dusty environments, and position the box close to the power supply to reduce voltage drop and power loss. The installation height is typically between 1.5 and 1.8 meters above the ground for convenient operation and inspection. Secure mounting using brackets or screws is essential to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration or impact .

Wiring Specifications

- **Power Off During Installation:** Always disconnect power before wiring to ensure safety .
- **Wire Type and Size:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the expected load current. Proper sizing prevents overheating and ensures reliable operation .
- **Cable Management:** Maintain neat wiring, avoid exposed copper, and clearly label all wires for identification. Use bushings or smooth surfaces at entry points to prevent abrasion .
