

# Standard for Fiber Optic Channels in Building Corridors



## Summary of Content

### Physical Installation Considerations

- **Conduit and Ducts:** Fiber cables should be installed in riser-rated or plenum-rated conduits depending on the building code. Vertical risers in corridors must comply with fire and safety regulations, and horizontal runs should avoid sharp bends or compression.
- **Bend Radius:** Maintain the manufacturer-specified minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss or fiber damage. Typically, this is 10 times the cable diameter for static bends and 20 times for dynamic bends.
