

Standard for Galvanized Thickness of Cable Tray Cover Plates



Summary of Content

The galvanized layer on a cable tray cover plate typically has a minimum local thickness of 45 μm for standard steel plates, with heavier components requiring $\geq 55 \mu\text{m}$.

Typical Zinc Coating Thickness

For steel cable tray cover plates with a thickness of 1.5 mm to 3 mm, the local zinc coating thickness should be no less than 45 μm , which corresponds to a coating mass of at least 325 g/m². Heavier components, such as brackets or supports thicker than 3 mm, require a minimum zinc thickness of 55 μm to ensure adequate corrosion protection .

- Local thickness: Minimum value at any single test point, measured with a magnetic thickness gauge. All points must meet the requirement.
- Mean coating mass: Average zinc mass per unit area of the entire workpiece, determined gravimetrically, ensuring uniform protection across the surface .

Galvanization Methods

The thickness of the zinc layer depends on the galvanization process:

- Hot-dip galvanization: Steel is dipped in molten zinc, producing a thicker, more durable coating that covers all surfaces, including edges and joints. This method provides superior corrosion resistance, especially in outdoor or humid environments .
