

Standard for Secondary Distribution Boxes in Construction Sites



Summary of Content

Secondary distribution boxes on construction sites must be installed in safe, accessible, and well-ventilated locations, with proper mounting, wiring, and grounding to ensure operational safety and compliance with electrical codes.

Site Selection

The distribution box should be located close to the power supply to minimize power loss and ensure safety. Avoid areas that are humid, corrosive, or poorly ventilated, as these conditions can damage equipment or cause overheating. The site should allow easy access for inspection and maintenance while keeping the box protected from accidental impacts or environmental hazards .

Installation Height and Mounting

The bottom edge of the distribution box is typically installed 1.5 to 1.8 meters above ground, which facilitates operation and inspection. The box must be firmly fixed using suitable mounting brackets or screws to prevent movement, tilting, or vibration-related damage. Temporary construction sites may require additional stabilization to account for uneven terrain or frequent relocation .

Wiring Specifications

- Power must be turned off during installation to ensure safety.
- Use high-temperature resistant copper-core wires, with cross-sectional areas appropriate for the expected load current.
