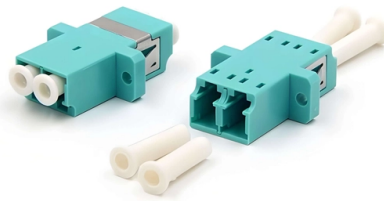


Standard thickness of galvanized metal cable trays



Summary of Content

The typical thickness of galvanized metal cable trays ranges from 1.5 mm to 3 mm for side and base plates, with zinc coating thickness of at least 45 μm for standard components.

Cable Tray Sheet Thickness

The sheet metal thickness for galvanized cable trays generally depends on the tray type and load requirements:

- Side plates and base plates: 1.5 mm to 3 mm is standard for most trays .
- Brackets, supports, and heavier components: Often exceed 3 mm to provide additional mechanical strength .

This thickness ensures adequate structural integrity while supporting the weight of cables and environmental loads. Manufacturers may adjust thickness based on span length, cable load, and installation environment .

Zinc Coating Standards

Galvanized cable trays are coated with zinc to prevent corrosion. The zinc coating thickness is specified as:

- Minimum local thickness: 45 μm (corresponding to a coating mass of 325 g/m^2) for standard tray sheets .
- Heavier components: Minimum 55 μm for brackets and supports .
