

Standardized cable tray dimensions



Summary of Content

Standard cable trays typically range from 50mm to 900mm in width, 50mm to 150mm in depth, and are commonly 3 meters long.

Width

The width of a cable tray is the primary factor determining cable capacity. Standard nominal widths range from 50mm (small control circuits) up to 900mm (large power or industrial runs). The listed width refers to the inside usable width, while the outside width is slightly larger due to side rail thickness, which is important for wall or floor penetrations and fitting compatibility .

Depth

The depth (or side rail height) controls vertical stacking capacity and affects heat dissipation and NEC fill compliance. Typical depths range from 50mm to 150mm, ensuring cables remain secure and properly spaced to prevent overheating .

Length

Cable trays are usually manufactured in 3-meter (approximately 10-foot) segments, which balances ease of transport with installation efficiency. This length is standard across most manufacturers and allows for modular installation in long runs .

Material Thickness

Material thickness varies depending on the tray type and load requirements. Common materials include steel, aluminum, and fiberglass, with thicknesses designed to support the expected cable weight and maintain structural integrity over the span .
