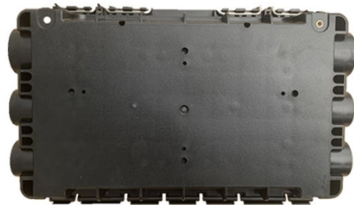


Standards for Optical Cable Usage

Optical cables must meet international standards covering fiber type, mechanical durability, environmental resistance, and optical performance to ensure reliability and interoperability.

Fiber Types and Optical Performance

Optical cables are classified by fiber type, including single-mode (SMF) and multimode (MMF), each with defined optical characteristics. Key standards include ITU-T G.652 for general-purpose single-mode fibers, G.655 for non-zero dispersion-shifted fibers optimized for DWDM systems, and G.657 for bend-insensitive fibers. Multimode fibers are specified under IEC 60793-2-10 (OM3/OM4) and single-mode fibers under IEC 60793-2-50 (G.652D, G.657) to ensure low attenuation, controlled dispersion, and sufficient bandwidth for intended applications .

Cable Design and Construction

The IEC 60794 standard governs the design and construction of optical fiber cables, including fiber arrangement, strength members, protective layers, and jacketing materials. Requirements cover tensile strength, bend radius limits, crush resistance, impact resistance, and environmental protection to ensure durability in indoor, outdoor, aerial, duct, or direct-buried installations . Indoor cables are specified under IEC 60794-2, while outdoor cables follow IEC 60794-3.
