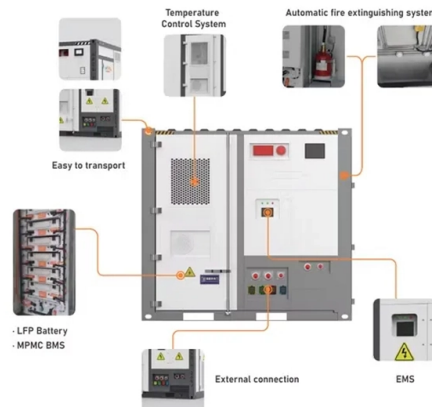


Standards for the Structural Requirements of Distribution Box Openings



Summary of Content

Distribution box openings must be designed to allow safe cable entry and exit, maintain structural integrity, and comply with IP/NEMA protection standards.

Material and Mechanical Considerations

Distribution boxes are typically fabricated from cold-rolled steel or galvanized steel with a minimum thickness of 1.5–2.0 mm for the enclosure and doors, and 3.0 mm for back panels to ensure rigidity and durability . Openings for incoming and outgoing cables should be reinforced to prevent deformation and maintain the box's structural strength. Detachable plates or knockouts are commonly used to allow flexibility in cable routing while preserving the enclosure's integrity .

Opening Design and Sealing

The size, shape, and number of openings must comply with national standards, design drawings, and standard parameter requirements . Each opening should be equipped with heavy-duty cable glands or seals that meet Class 3 sealing requirements, ensuring protection against dust and water ingress after cable installation . For outdoor boxes, the roof is often slanted with an overhang to prevent water accumulation, and openings should not compromise the IP-55 or equivalent protection rating .
