- **Maintain Bend Radius:** Optical fibers must not be bent too tightly. A typical bend radius is 100–130 mm, usually around 110 mm, to prevent signal loss or damage.
- **Vertical Routing:** Route cables vertically along the sides of racks or devices to avoid obstructing airflow and access to ports.
- **Bundling:** Group cables into bundles using steel ties at regular intervals. Avoid over-tightening to prevent crushing the fibers.
- **Separation of Cable Types:** Keep power and data/optical cables separate to reduce interference and maintain organization.
- **Labeling:** Clearly label each cable or bundle to ensure easy identification and maintenance.
