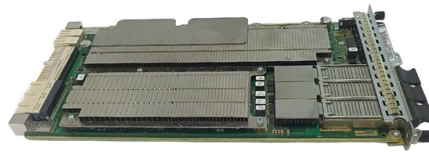


Switch fiber optic module connection cable

1. SFP/SFP+ Modules: Small Form-factor Pluggable (SFP) or SFP+ transceivers are used to interface switches with fiber optic cables. SFP modules support 1 Gbps, while SFP+ modules can handle higher speeds up to 10 Gbps. Modules must match the type of fiber being used—single-mode for long distances or multimode for shorter distances—and are typically designed for LC connectors (). 2. Fiber Optic Cables: Duplex fiber optic cables, consisting of two strands, are standard for SFP connections. Each strand carries either the transmit or receive signal. Cables can be pre-terminated with LC connectors to simplify installation and reduce labor costs. Single-mode cables are used for long-distance links, while multimode cables are suitable for shorter distances (). 3. Media Converters (Optional): If a switch lacks SFP ports, a fiber media converter can be used to convert electrical Ethernet signals to optical signals, enabling integration with fiber networks. This allows legacy copper-based switches to connect to fiber infrastructure without replacing existing hardware ().

Installation Steps

- Verify that the switch has available SFP/SFP+ ports compatible with the chosen module.
- Insert the SFP module into the switch port, ensuring it is securely locked. These modules are hot-swappable, so the switch does not need to be powered down ().
