

Switch fiber optic to electrical port 6

To switch a fiber optic connection to an electrical (copper) port, you typically use a fiber-to-Ethernet media converter or connect to a switch with both fiber and copper ports.

Using a Switch with Both Fiber and Copper Ports

Many industrial or managed switches, such as the ConneXium Extended Managed Switch, come with dedicated fiber ports (100BASE-FX) and copper ports (10/100BASE-TX). To move a connection from fiber to copper, you can simply plug the Ethernet cable into one of the available copper ports and configure the switch to route traffic through that port if necessary. Ensure the switch supports auto-negotiation and proper VLAN or port settings to maintain network functionality.

Using a Fiber-to-Ethernet Media Converter

If your switch only has fiber ports or you need to connect to a standard Ethernet device, a fiber-to-Cat6 or fiber-to-RJ45 media converter is required. These devices convert the optical signal into an electrical Ethernet signal compatible with copper cabling. Key points for using a media converter:

- Select the correct type: multimode for short distances (up to ~550 meters) or single-mode for long distances (up to 10 km) depending on your fiber cable.
- Connect the fiber cable to the converter's fiber port (LC/SFP module) and the Ethernet cable to the copper port.
- Power the converter using the included power supply.
