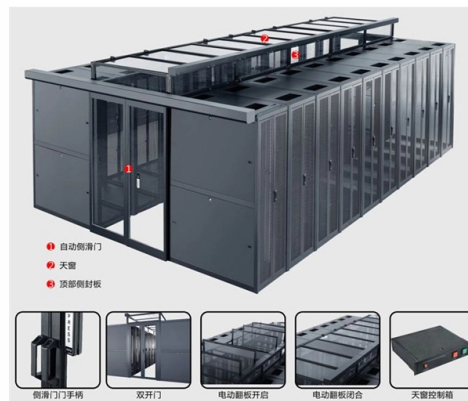


Switch models that support optical splitters

Overview

Optical switches with splitter capabilities are designed to manage multiple Toslink/SPDIF audio sources and route them to one or more outputs. These devices are ideal for home theaters, gaming consoles, Blu-ray players, and soundbars. They often include remote control, manual switching, and over-voltage protection to maintain signal integrity and prevent damage to connected devices .

Common Configurations

- **3x1 Switch:** Three inputs, one output. Allows switching between three sources to a single output device. Supports Dolby Digital, DTS 5.1, and LPCM 2.0. Examples: J-Tech Digital 3x1 SPDIF switch, AUBEAMTO 3x1 optical switch .
- **1x2 or 1x3 Splitter:** One input, two or three outputs. Enables sending the same audio signal to multiple devices simultaneously. Examples: LiNKFOR 1x3 digital optical splitter, BlueRigger 1x2/1x3 Toslink splitter .
- **4x2 Matrix Switch:** Four inputs, two outputs. Combines switching and splitting, allowing multiple sources to be routed to multiple outputs. Example: Fosmon 4x2 HDMI matrix with SPDIF optical output .
