

Technical Recommendations for Drop Cable Laying

Proper drop cable laying requires adherence to standards, careful handling, correct routing, and protection measures to ensure long-term reliability and safety.

Cable Selection and Preparation

Choose the appropriate cable type based on the installation environment: FTTH flat drop cables or aerial drop cables for overhead installations, and suitable twisted pair or coaxial cables for copper networks . Prepare the cable ends according to manufacturer guidelines, including splicing, termination, and connector attachment, to maintain signal integrity .

Routing and Path Considerations

- Clear the installation path of debris, vegetation, or obstacles for both aerial and underground routes .
- Minimize sharp bends and tight corners; maintain a minimum bending radius of 20 times the cable diameter during installation and 10 times for static use .
- For long runs, use gentle curves and avoid unsupported spans to reduce mechanical stress .

Pulling and Tension

- Limit pulling tension to 80-100 N for manual installation; use a tension meter for long-distance pulls to prevent over-tensioning .
