Switch testing involves verifying functionality, performance, reliability, and environmental resilience to ensure proper operation under expected conditions.

1. Functional Testing

Functional testing ensures the switch performs its intended operations correctly. For network switches, this includes verifying port configuration, VLAN assignments, packet forwarding, filtering, and protocol compliance such as IEEE 802.3, IPv4, IPv6, and QoS standards. For electrical switches, functional testing checks that the switch establishes and maintains a continuous electrical path when actuated, confirming correct open and closed states .

2. Performance Testing

Performance testing evaluates how the switch handles high data throughput, latency, packet loss, and jitter for network switches, or measures resistance and voltage drop for electrical switches. This step ensures the device meets speed, bandwidth, and operational standards under load conditions .

3. Reliability and Durability Testing

This step assesses the switch's longevity and ability to withstand repeated operations. Network switches are tested for sustained performance over time, while electrical switches undergo repeated actuation cycles to detect degradation or failure .
