Risks of an Ungrounded Distribution Box

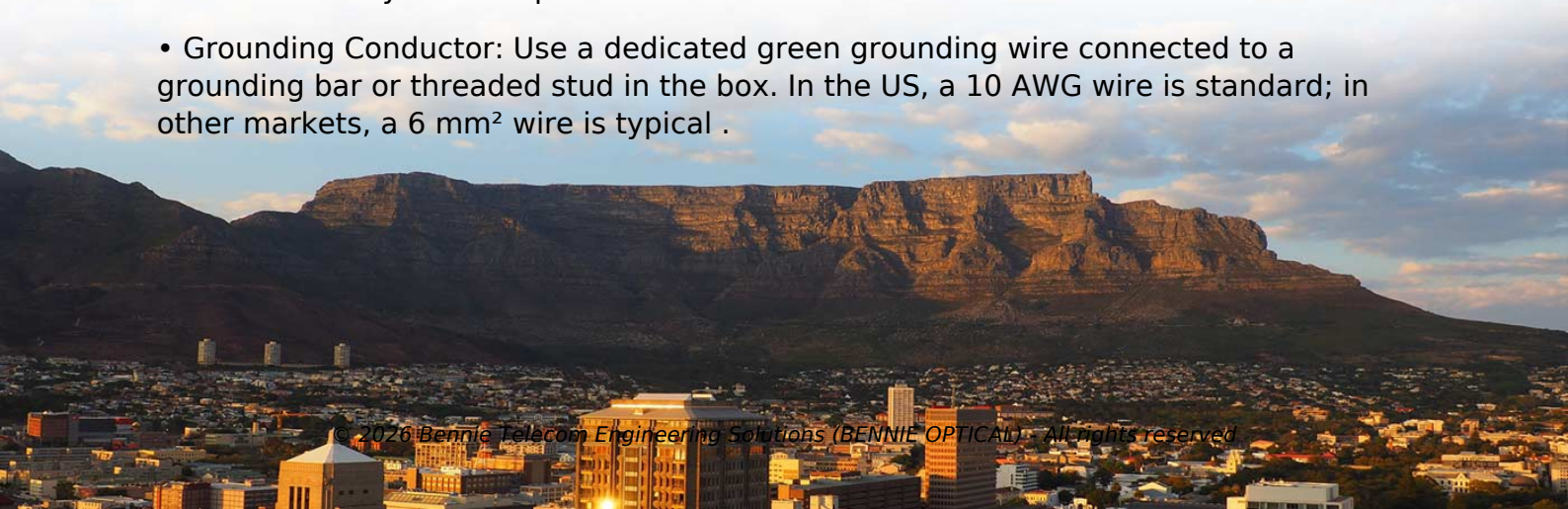
A distribution box that is not grounded can create multiple hazards:

- **Electric Shock:** If a live wire accidentally contacts the metal enclosure, anyone touching the box can become a path to earth, risking severe injury or death .
- **Equipment Damage:** Ungrounded boxes cannot safely dissipate fault currents or surges, which can damage sensitive electrical components .
- **Code Violations:** NEC 250.148 mandates that all metallic parts of electrical enclosures, including doors, must be bonded to ground . Failure to comply can result in inspection failures and legal liability.

Proper Grounding Practices

To ensure safety and compliance:

- **Grounding Conductor:** Use a dedicated green grounding wire connected to a grounding bar or threaded stud in the box. In the US, a 10 AWG wire is standard; in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is typical .
