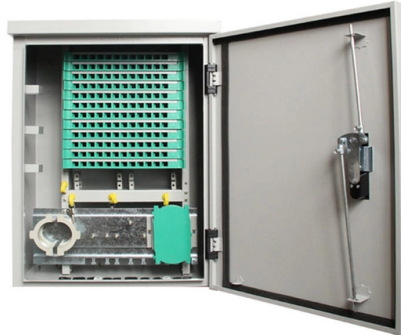


The door is opposite the electrical distribution box

Clearance Requirements

Electrical panels require a dedicated working space to ensure safe operation, maintenance, and emergency access. The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies that the front of the panel must have a minimum 36 inches of clear depth and a 30-inch width or the full width of the panel, whichever is greater. This space must allow the panel door to open at least 90 degrees without obstruction, ensuring full access to breakers and internal components .

Door Placement Considerations

If a door is directly opposite the panel, it must not impede the required working space. The door should either open in a way that does not block the 36-inch depth or remain closed during panel operation. The panel's front clearance is critical for technician safety, preventing awkward or dangerous positions while servicing the equipment .

Safety and Accessibility

- Panel doors (outer doors) provide everyday access to breakers while shielding live components .
- Dead fronts (inner covers) protect users from energized parts, exposing only breaker handles .
