Avoid bending them sharply or placing them under tension. Keep the connectors clean and handle them by the plastic housing to prevent damage . 6. **Practical Setup Sequence** Power on the ONT first to allow it to establish a connection with your ISP. Once the ONT is stable, power on the router. This ensures proper initialization and avoids connectivity issues .
