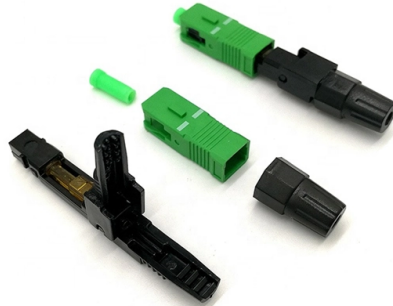

- **Identify the Connector Type:** Ensure the fiber optic patch cable matches the patch panel adapter type. For example, LC connectors are commonly used for high-density equipment-to-equipment connections, while SC or FC connectors are often used for Optical Distribution Frame (ODF) terminations .
- **Front and Back Panel Connections:** Typically, a short patch cable connects the front of the patch panel to network equipment, while a longer cable runs from the back of the panel to the main fiber backbone or ODF . This setup allows the patch panel to act as a flexible intermediary without requiring direct splicing to equipment.
