LC (Lucent Connector) is a widely adopted fiber optic interface, originally developed by Lucent Technologies. It features a 1.25 mm ferrule, which is half the size of the SC connector's 2.5 mm ferrule, allowing for higher port density in switches, routers, and optical modules . The LC connector uses a push-pull latch mechanism, similar to RJ45 connectors, making it easier and faster to connect and disconnect compared to threaded or bayonet-style connectors . LC connectors are fully aligned with TIA/EIA-604 standards, ensuring cross-vendor compatibility .

Use in Optical Modules

Optical modules such as SFP, SFP+, SFP28, QSFP+, and QSFP28 typically present LC duplex interfaces for fiber connections . The LC interface aligns the fiber core precisely with the optical transmitter and receiver inside the module, minimizing insertion loss and maintaining signal quality . This alignment is critical in high-bandwidth applications, where even small losses can affect performance.

Advantages of LC Interfaces

- High-density deployment: LC connectors allow more ports per rack unit, which is essential in modern data centers and high-speed networks .
