Overview

The removal of a pigtail catheter is a simple and quick process. The doctor will first clean the insertion site and apply a local anesthetic to numb the area. A pigtail catheter is a flexible drainage tube with a secure, coiled tip, inserted using a minimally invasive technique to remove unwanted fluid or. Emergency Medicine Cases offers these excellent tips on pigtail catheters placement. PEARL # 1 – LOCATION/LANDMARK: Minimize skin to pleural distance. Often the region with the least amount of adipose/muscle tissue will be in the 4th to 5th ICS, mid to anterior. PURPOSE: To outline the indications and procedure guideline for the insertion and removal of a chest tube (tube thoracostomy) or a pigtail catheter in a trauma patient. Proper re-expansion of the lungs permits adequate. Make a small incision with 11-blade alongside guidewire, then dilate to required depth with dilator, then insert pigtail with obturator over wire to appropriate depth.
