Core Functions

This allows seamless communication between the central office and customer premises. **Traffic Management:** These modules facilitate the multiplexing of data between the OLT and multiple Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) or Optical Network Units (ONUs), ensuring that each subscriber receives the correct data stream . **Bandwidth Allocation:** OLT modules support dynamic bandwidth allocation (DBA), enabling the OLT to assign bandwidth efficiently to each connected ONU based on demand, which is critical for high-bandwidth applications like 4K streaming, VoIP, and video conferencing . **Network Scalability:** Each OLT port, equipped with an optical module, can drive a PON network with split ratios typically ranging from 1:32 to 1:128, allowing a single module to serve multiple subscribers simultaneously . This makes it ideal for large-scale FTTH or FTTB deployments. **Protocol Support:** OLT optical modules are designed to support various PON standards, including GPON, XG-PON, XGS-PON, and EPON, enabling network upgrades and integration of 1G and 10G networks when used with combo OLTs . **Maintenance and Monitoring:** Through these modules, operators can remotely monitor, configure, and manage ONUs using protocols like OMCI, reducing on-site maintenance and ensuring network reliability .
