Configuration Steps for H3C Switches

To configure port aggregation on H3C switches, follow these general steps:

- **Create an Aggregation Group:** Use the command to create a link aggregation group (LAG). For example:

```
interface Bridge-Aggregation 1
```

- **Add Member Ports:** Assign physical interfaces to the aggregation group. For example:

```
interface GigabitEthernet 1/0/1port link-aggregation group 1
```
