

The wire end connected to the distribution box is too thick



Overview

In order to avoid very thick cables, the first thing you should consider is to increase the system voltage. A system with a large inverter will cause large DC currents. This circuit is for the diesel heater, which runs 18 feet away from the distribution panel (36 feet total) with a power draw of 15 amps. The original setup had two sets going into the push-in connections and one set connected with the white wire on the lower terminal and the black on the upper terminal. Overcrowded junction boxes, loose wire splices, and poorly. They are currently run into the hot tub's box. What should I do?

Should I remove some strands from the ground wire to make it fit?
