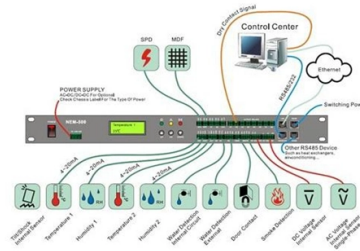
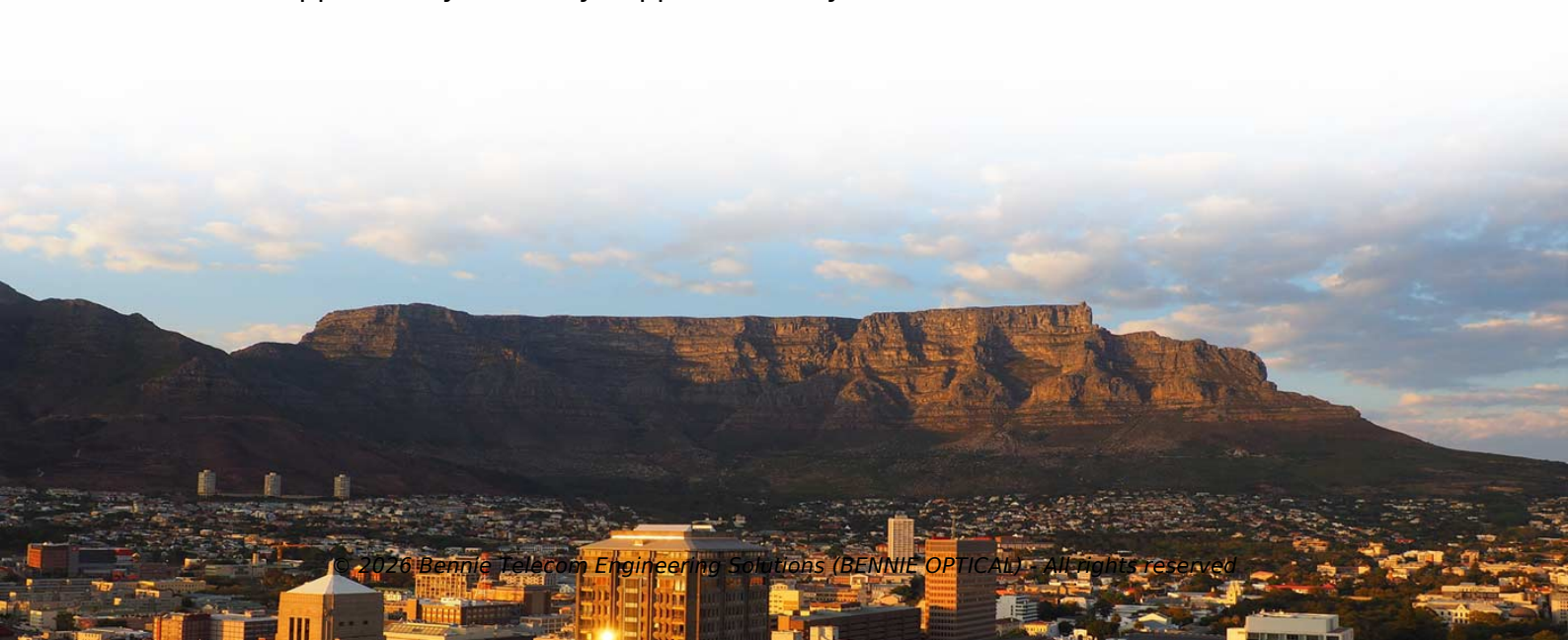


Theoretical weight of angle steel cable tray support



Overview

The weight is calculated by multiplying the specific material density—like steel, aluminum, or stainless steel—by the volume of the tray structure. A calculator simplifies this by using standard dimensions such as width, height, length, and material thickness to provide an. Calculator Note: Cable Tray weight is the major component of dead load. The proper selection between the two depends on factors such as load-bearing capacity, installation environment, and the ease of future adjustments. This article explores these. Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: $\text{Support Quantity} = \frac{\text{Total Length}}{\text{Support Spacing}} + 1$. In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports. Cable tray supports are components used to fix and support. Tray normally supported every 2 m, 2.
