Purpose of Multiple Distribution Boxes

In a typical home, several distribution boxes may be used to manage electricity efficiently and safely. Sub-distribution boards (SDBs) are smaller boxes that serve specific areas or floors, allowing localized control and easier maintenance without shutting down the entire system.

Key Components

Each distribution box generally contains:

- Main Switch: Controls the entire electrical system and allows emergency shutdown.
- Circuit Breakers (MCBs or MCCBs): Protect individual circuits from overload or short circuits.
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs): Provide additional protection against electric shocks.
- Busbars and Terminal Blocks: Distribute power internally and connect circuits safely.
