The perforations also make it easier to position and secure cables and allow for smooth cable pulling during installation .

Structural Considerations

Perforated trays are made from materials like stainless steel, galvanized steel, or aluminum, providing strong support for heavy cable loads while maintaining durability and corrosion resistance . The holes can be round, square, oval, or slotted, depending on the design, and are engineered to maintain structural integrity while offering ventilation . This design is a compromise between solid-bottom trays, which offer maximum protection but limited airflow, and ladder trays, which provide open support but less continuous cable support .
