Safety and Access Requirements

Electrical panels, also known as breaker boxes, must be installed in a location that allows immediate and unobstructed access for maintenance and emergency shutoff . The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies that the working space in front of a panel must be at least 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high to ensure safe operation . The panel door must be able to open a full 90 degrees, allowing complete access to the breakers inside . These clearances are critical even if the panel is behind a door, as the door itself should not restrict the required working space.
