A thick fiber optic pigtail can be spliced to a leather cable using fusion or mechanical splicing to create a reliable, low-loss connection.

Understanding the Components

Fiber optic pigtail: A short optical fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and an exposed fiber on the other. The exposed end is designed to be spliced to another fiber, providing a clean, low-loss interface for network equipment (Holight Optic, Gezhi Photonics, QSFptek) . **Leather cable:** A reinforced fiber optic cable, often with one, two, or four cores, designed with a central fiber surrounded by mechanical protection and a low-smoke halogen-free sheath. This structure provides durability and safety for indoor wiring and access networks (DMiscables) .

Splicing Methods

- **Fusion Splicing:**
 - Uses a fusion splicer to align and weld the fiber ends with an electric arc.
 - Produces a permanent, low-loss connection (typically ~0.1 dB attenuation) with minimal back reflection.
 - Ideal for joining a thick pigtail to a leather cable in distribution boxes or ODFs, ensuring long-term reliability (VChung, Gezhi Photonics) .
- **Mechanical Splicing:**
 - Aligns the fibers in a mechanical holder with an index-matching gel to transmit light.
