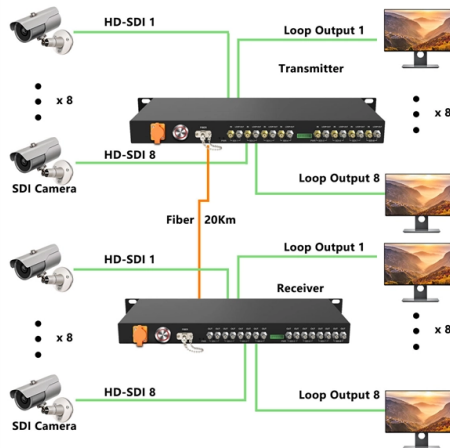

- **Weight Considerations:** Thicker aluminum increases protection but also adds weight, which is critical for pole or tower-mounted installations .

- **Standard outdoor splice boxes:** 2 mm to 3 mm aluminum alloy sheets are commonly used for general-purpose enclosures.
