Top-of-Rack (ToR) refers to a network switch placed at the top of a server rack, connecting all servers within the rack and simplifying data center networking.

Overview

A Top-of-Rack (ToR) switch is installed at the upper section of a server rack and serves as the primary connection point for all servers in that rack. Each server connects to the ToR switch using short copper or optical cables, which then aggregates the traffic and uplinks it to higher-level aggregation or core switches . This localized approach reduces cabling complexity, improves manageability, and enhances network performance .

Key Components and Features

- **High-Density Ports:** ToR switches typically support 10GbE, 25GbE, 40GbE, 100GbE, or higher, allowing multiple servers to connect efficiently .
- **Low Latency:** Short cable runs and predictable hop counts reduce latency, which is critical for virtualization, storage traffic, and cloud workloads .
- **Flexible Placement:** While commonly installed at the top of the rack, ToR switches can also be placed in the middle or bottom, depending on routing and airflow considerations .
- **Advanced Capabilities:** Modern ToR switches support L2/L3 switching, QoS, ACLs, EVPN, VXLAN, and high-capacity forwarding to handle dense server environments .
