Types of Optical Cable Faults

- **Complete Optical Cable Interruption** This occurs when the entire fiber cable is broken, often due to severe mechanical damage or excavation accidents. It usually requires centralized repair, splicing, or replacement of the affected section to restore service .
- **Partial Bundle or Fiber Interruption** Only some fibers within a cable bundle are damaged. This can result from localized stress, rodent damage, or minor mechanical impacts. Repairs focus on the affected fibers without disturbing the rest of the bundle, often using skylight connections or targeted splicing .
- **Connector and Splice Failures** Faults at connectors or splices are common due to contamination, misalignment, or poor polishing. Symptoms include high insertion loss, unusual reflectance, or intermittent connectivity. Cleaning and inspection with a fiber microscope or re-termination often resolves these issues .
- **Bends and Microbends**
 - **Macrobends:** Large curves exceeding the cable's minimum bend radius cause light leakage and signal attenuation.
 - **Microbends:** Small-scale distortions from uneven pressure or tight packing can also degrade performance. Proper cable routing, bend-insensitive fibers, and mechanical protection prevent these faults .
