A base station represents an access point for a wireless device to communicate within its coverage area. " A base station is called node B in 3G, eNB in LTE (4G), and gNB in 5G. The term is used in the context of mobile. A cell site, cell phone tower, cell base tower, or cellular base station is a cellular -enabled mobile device site where antennas and electronic communications equipment are placed on a raised structure (typically on a radio mast, or tower) to create a cell, or adjacent cells, in a cellular. Base stations and cell towers are critical components of cellular communication systems, serving as the infrastructure that supports seamless mobile connectivity.
