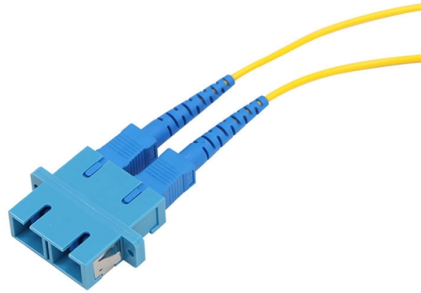


Volume of optical fiber cable
