- ANSI Z535: The ANSI Z535.4 standard provides guidelines for hazard symbols, lettering, and color schemes. Warning signs typically use a yellow triangle with a black border and black pictogram to indicate electrical hazards.
- NFPA 79: Electrical enclosures that do not clearly show they contain electrical devices must be marked with safety signs in accordance with ANSI Z535 standards. Signs should be visible on the enclosure door or cover and positioned so qualified personnel can see them before servicing or maintenance.
