

What are the different span types of ADSS optical cables

ADSS optical cables are categorized by span type into short, medium, and long-span designs, each optimized for specific distances between support structures.

Short-Span ADSS Cables

Short-span cables are designed for distances typically up to 50 meters between poles. An example is the GYFXTBY fiber optic cable, which is ideal for urban or compact installations where poles are closely spaced. These cables are lightweight and easy to install but are limited in tensile strength and span length, making them suitable for short-distance aerial applications .

Medium-Span ADSS Cables

Medium-span cables cover distances ranging from 50 meters to 200 meters. Examples include ASU cables and ADSS-S cables. ADSS-S cables feature a single-jacket design, providing increased protection and durability while maintaining flexibility for medium-span aerial installations. These cables are commonly used in suburban or rural areas where moderate distances between poles are required .
