Design involves selecting the network architecture, such as hub-and-spoke or Passive Optical Network (PON) layouts, and determining whether cables will be installed aerially on poles or underground in trenches . Site surveys assess terrain, existing utilities, and potential obstacles like rivers or highways .

Installation Methods

Fiber optic cables are typically installed in segments and may require splicing to create continuous links or to branch off to individual homes or businesses .
