

What are the requirements for installing cable tray supports

- Horizontal Runs: NEC recommends supports at intervals not exceeding 5 feet, with an ideal range of 4–6 feet depending on tray type and load .
- Tray Type Influence: Ladder trays, perforated trays, and wire mesh trays may have different spacing requirements; ladder tray rungs should not exceed 9 inches apart .
