Regulatory Compliance

- Bend Radius: Maintain the cable's minimum bend radius as specified by the manufacturer to prevent signal loss, attenuation, or fiber damage .
- Pulling Tension: Never exceed the maximum pulling tension; always pull by the cable jacket or strength members, not the fibers themselves .
- Cable Protection: Avoid sharp edges, turn-backs, and excessive pressure points. Use inner ducts or protective materials for cables exposed during installation .
- Vertical Support: Clamp vertical runs at frequent intervals to prevent the cable weight from exceeding long-term load limits .
