Compatibility

Ensure the SFP module is compatible with your network device. Modules must adhere to MSA (Multi-Source Agreement) standards for mechanical dimensions and pinouts, but electrical and optical compatibility must also be verified. Some switches enforce vendor-specific EEPROM coding, and using an unsupported module can result in ports remaining down or error messages. Always check the host device documentation and confirm that the module is recognized and supported.

Data Rate and Module Type

Select a module that matches the port speed of your switch or router. Common types include:

- SFP: 1-4 Gbps
- SFP+: up to 10 Gbps
- SFP28: 25 Gbps
- QSFP: 40-100 Gbps for aggregation Using a module with an incompatible data rate can prevent the link from establishing or degrade performance
