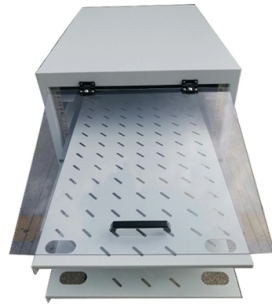


What are the sources of high temperatures in outdoor server racks



Summary of Content

High temperatures in outdoor server racks are primarily caused by internal heat from equipment, poor airflow, environmental exposure, and solar radiation.

Internal Heat Generation

Servers and IT equipment generate substantial heat during normal operation. CPUs, GPUs, hard drives, and power supplies convert most of their electrical energy into heat, which accumulates inside the rack if not properly managed. High-density setups or adding more equipment increases the internal heat load, raising temperatures rapidly and potentially triggering thermal protection mechanisms or hardware throttling .

Airflow and Ventilation Issues

Improper airflow is a major contributor to localized hot spots. Servers are designed for front-to-back airflow, but blocked intake vents, obstructed exhausts, or poor cable management can cause recirculation of hot air. This reduces the efficiency of cooling systems and allows heat to build up inside the enclosure . In outdoor racks, exposure to wind or dust can further complicate airflow management.
