

What are the technical standards for optical fiber cables

Optical fiber cables must comply with international standards covering optical performance, mechanical robustness, environmental resistance, and safety, including ITU-T, IEC, TIA, ISO/IEC, and Telcordia specifications.

Key International Standards

ITU-T Recommendations define optical fiber characteristics and transmission performance. Important standards include:

- G.652: Baseline single-mode fiber with low attenuation and zero dispersion at 1310 nm, widely used in backbone and general-purpose networks.
- G.655: Non-zero dispersion-shifted fiber optimized for DWDM systems to reduce nonlinear effects.
- G.657: Bend-insensitive single-mode fiber compatible with G.652, suitable for FTTH and tight-bend installations . IEC Standards focus on fiber and cable specifications, testing, and durability:
 - IEC 60793-2-50: Single-mode fiber specifications, including core/cladding dimensions, attenuation, and bending loss.
 - IEC 60794 series: Cable construction and performance, covering indoor (60794-2) and outdoor (60794-3) cables, tensile strength, crush resistance, impact resistance, and environmental conditions like temperature cycling and moisture .
 - IEC 60332: Flame-retardant and fire safety testing for cable jackets.
