

What does GCT represent for cable trays

GCT stands for "Grounding Conductor Tray," referring to a cable tray designed or rated to serve as an equipment grounding conductor (EGC) in electrical installations.

Definition and Purpose

In cable tray systems, GCT indicates that the tray itself can safely carry fault currents and act as a grounding path for electrical circuits. This is critical for protecting personnel and equipment from electrical faults, as the tray provides a low-impedance path to ground, ensuring that overcurrent protection devices operate correctly .

Key Considerations

- **Material and Construction:** Only metallic trays (steel, aluminum, or stainless steel) with sufficient cross-sectional area can be used as a GCT. The tray must be electrically continuous and properly bonded at joints to maintain grounding integrity .
- **Compliance with Standards:** GCT-rated trays must meet NEC requirements (e.g., NEC Sections 250-51, 318-6(a)) and may also comply with IEC 61537 for international installations .
- **Installation Practices:** When using a cable tray as a GCT, grounding clamps or bonding jumpers may be installed to ensure continuity, especially in segmented or modular tray systems. Bare copper conductors are generally avoided in aluminum trays to prevent corrosion; insulated conductors are preferred for bonding .
