Role of the Router and ONT

Routers cannot directly interpret light signals from fiber cables. Instead, the fiber line terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), usually provided by your internet service provider. The ONT performs optoelectronic conversion, translating the incoming light signals into standard electrical signals that your router can process. After conversion, the ONT outputs data through an Ethernet port, which connects to the router's WAN port.

Setting Up the Connection

- Install the ONT: Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port. Handle the fiber connector carefully to avoid damage.
