

What does single-fiber bidirectional mean

Single-fiber bidirectional (BiDi) refers to the ability to transmit and receive data simultaneously over a single optical fiber using two different wavelengths.

Overview

In traditional fiber optic systems, a single fiber typically carries data in only one direction, requiring a second fiber for full-duplex communication. Single-fiber bidirectional technology allows both transmission (TX) and reception (RX) to occur on the same fiber strand, effectively doubling the efficiency of fiber usage without adding extra cables .

How It Works

Single-fiber bidirectional communication relies on wavelength division multiplexing (WDM). Each direction of data flow is assigned a distinct wavelength. For example, a transceiver at one end may transmit at 1310 nm and receive at 1490 nm, while the opposite end uses the inverse configuration. A diplexer or internal WDM filter separates the two wavelengths, ensuring that signals traveling in opposite directions do not interfere with each other .

Advantages

- **Fiber Efficiency:** Reduces fiber usage by approximately 50%, which is especially valuable in fiber-constrained environments like metro networks, campus links, and data centers .
- **Cost Savings:** Fewer fibers mean lower installation, leasing, and maintenance costs .
